GEORGE TOWN MUNICIPALITY LOAN.

The Committee further considered the question of a loan of £8000 for the purpose of constructing a pipe-line, reservoir, &c., to supply the Port of Bell Bay and district withwater. After hearing and considering the evidence of Mr. Donald Fraser, engineer of the proposed works, the Committee resolved to recommend the granting of the loan, with a sinking fund of one and a quarter per cent.
