REPORT.

THE Standing Committee on Public Accounts has the honour to submit the following Report to the favourable consideration of your Honourable House :—

WESTBURY COUNCIL APPLICATION.

Your Committee, having taken into consideration an application from the Westbury Council for a loan of £6000 for the purpose of providing for the lighting of portion of the Municipality of Westbury by electricity and supplying electrical energy, recommends the same to the favourable consideration of your Honourable House, with provision to be made in the Bill to grant such loan for a Sinking Fund of Two per cent.

ESPERANCE COUNCIL APPLICATION.

A further application considered by your Committee was from the Esperance Council for a loan of £7000 for the purpose of lighting of portion of the Municipality of Esperance by electricity. The application is recommended for approval with a Sinking Fund of Two per cent.
