THE Standing Committee on Public. Accounts has the honour to submit the following Report:—

TABLE CAPE MUNICIPALITY LOAN.

This was an application from the Table Cape Municipality for a loan of £500 for the extension of the Somerset-Elliott-Yolla power and lighting scheme from transformers Nos. 11 and 12.

A report was received from the General Manager and Chief Engineer of the Hydro-Electric Department approving of the loan for the purpose mentioned, and, after carefully considering the application, your Committee decided to recommend the granting of the loan, subject to provision being made in the Bill for interest to be at the rate of Five Pounds Fifteen Shillings per centum.
