## CLAUSE NOTES

## Appropriation (Further Supplementary Appropriation for 2023-24) Bill 2024

- Clause 1 This clause provides for the Short title of the Act to be the Appropriation (Further Supplementary Appropriation for 2023-24) Act 2024. This title makes it clear that the Act relates to a further (the second) supplementary appropriation from the Public Account for the 2023-24 financial year.
- Clause 2 This clause provides for the commencement of the Act from 1 July 2023. This commencement date facilitates the appropriation of the funds concerned for 2023-24.
- Clause 3 This clause provides for the interpretation of the terms Capital Services and Operating Services used in Schedule 1.
- Clause 4 This clause provides for the appropriation of \$82 050 000 and provides for the Treasurer to issue that amount from the Public Account in the 2023-24 financial year and to apply those funds for the services of the Government.
- Clause 5 This clause specifies that the amount of \$82 050 000 is to be applied for the purposes that are set out in Schedule 1 and detailed in the agency information in support of the estimates for the financial year ending on 30 June 2024 or the information tabled by the Minister in support of Schedule 1.
- Clause 6 This clause provides for the expiry of the Act on 30 June 2025.
