Midlands Highway - Signage

Mr FAIRS question to MINISTER for INFRASTRUCTURE

Constituents have raised concerns with me about the signage on the Midlands Highway, which states '116 kms - over is over'. Some believe that this signage could be seen as encouraging motorists to break the prescribed speed limit of 110 kilometres per hour. Speed continues to be the single biggest cause of serious casualty crashes in Tasmania, with one in three crashes being speed related. If we want motorists to rethink their attitudes to speeding and encourage them not to drive over the speed limit at any level, how does this signage help them achieve that?
