Short inquiry into the Tasmanian Government's response to serious allegations within harness racing

Inquiry progress update

The House of Assembly Standing Committee on Government Administration B continues with its short inquiry into the Tasmanian Government's response to serious allegations within harness racing.

The Committee invited specific persons or organisations to make written submissions, and to hearings to give evidence. Eight submissions have been published, and three public hearings have been held.

The Committee has invited former Racing Ministers, the Hon. Felix Ellis MP and the Hon. Madeleine Ogilvie MP, to give evidence in relation to the terms of reference and their time with the Racing portfolio. The Committee anticipates completing its evidence gathering after hearing from the former Racing Ministers.
