

LAUNCESTON FIRE BRIGADE BOARD: REPORT FOR 1892.

REPORT of the Launceston Fire Brigade Board for the Year ending 31st December, 1892.

To His Excellency SIR WILLIAM LAMBERT DOBSON, Knight, Chief Justice, Administrator of the Government of Tasmania.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY:

In pursuance of the "Fire Brigades Act," 47 Victoria, No. 21, this Board has the honor to report as follows:—

During the year the Brigade attended at (27) twenty-seven fires and alarms, and performed their duties in a satisfactory manner.

The total expenditure for the year, after deducting the amounts recovered on uninsured properties, sale of hose, and unclaimed amounts, is £811 8s. 4d., divided between the Government, Municipal Council, and Insurance Companies.

There have been twelve (12) meetings of the Board during the year.

The Fire Escape mentioned in the last Report has been ordered from London, and is expected to arrive shortly.

The Board regret having to report the death of their late Secretary, Mr. Frank E. Littler, who had been connected with the Brigade almost from its inception. Mr. Keith Ritchie has been appointed Secretary to the Board.
