

- The Superintendent has £15 per annum as Inspector under Rabbit Act, uniform, and £20 per annum forage allowance. The Superintendent has fuel and light, and the Constable quarters.
- Without uniform. 1 Constable has fuel and light. All are paid at an annual rate, and, with the exception of Superintendent, have quarters
- t Without uniform and quarters. The Superintendent has £5 per annum as Secretary Road Trust, £5 as Secretary Board of Advice, and £5 Secretary Fruit Board; all have forage.
- "With uniform and, except in case of Superintendent, quarters, fuel, and light. The 2 Sub-Inspectors and 2 Constables have £12 10s each forage allowance. 2 Sub-Inspectors and 2 Constables receive £1 5s per annum boot allowance.
