No receipts in excess of £50 are reckoned in the calculations. The deduction of 5s. 6½d. in the £ is made in every case. The calculation on the basis adopted came to £700 9s. 5d. The excess of 9s. 5d. was provided for by deducting one shilling from each of the under-mentioned Libraries, namely :—Campbell Town, Deloraine, Forth Town Hall, Longford, Mount Bischoff Mechanics' Athenæum, New Norfolk, New Town, Oatlands, and Westbury, and also 5d. from the Scottsdale Library.
