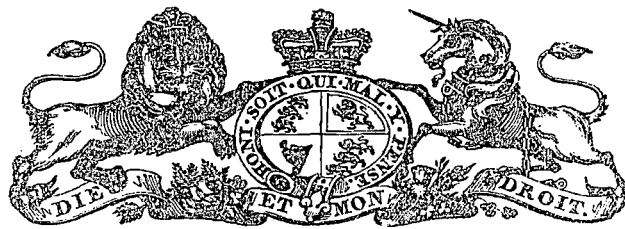

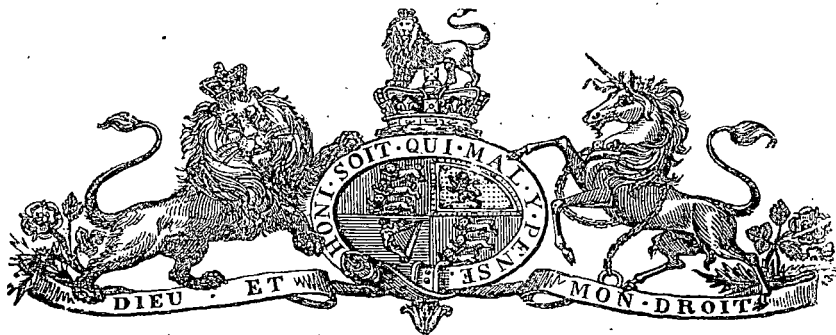

COMPARATIVE STATEMENT, GENERAL REVENUE, 1859.

Laid upon the Table by Mr. Colonial Treasurer, and ordered by the House to be printed, 22 August, 1860.



Audit Office, 18th August, 1860.

SIR,

I HAVE the honor to return herewith your Comparative Statement of the actual with the estimated Expenditure from General Revenue for the year 1859, which embraces as well all disbursements made during the year, as all arrears that have been paid up to the 31st March last for the service of the same.

This Statement has been carefully examined, compared, and reconciled with the Books of the Audit Department; and I have the satisfaction of reporting that there is no entry in it to which I can offer objection, either upon principle or as a matter of account, except as to a sum of £76 13s. 4d. which has been inadvertently credited to the vote for Education instead of to the Loans Bill for New Schools; an error which can be easily rectified by a Journal entry in the present year.

With regard to the Revenue, I have to remark that no Comparative Statement has been forwarded to me, agreeably to the requirement of 22nd Section of the Audit Act; but, as I have never been furnished with an Official Estimate of Revenue for 1859, I conclude that no such document was laid before Parliament, and that consequently no Comparative Statement could be prepared.

In the mean time, however, full details of the Revenue actually brought to account in that year will be found in the Statement of Receipts and Expenditure laid upon the Table of the House of Assembly on the 25th ultimo, from which Honorable Members will probably be able to obtain as much information as they may require.

I regret that I have to report a loss to the Revenue of the sum of £31 1s. 9d., which occurred in the last year, by embezzlement on the part of District Constable Duke, who absconded from Jerusalem on the 29th May with these moneys, consisting of—

Immediate steps were taken to pursue the defaulter, and he was followed to Victoria, but the Constable employed on the occasion was not successful in securing him.

There can be no question that the comparatively large amount received for Dog Licences was the immediate temptation to Duke to commit the felony, as the money must have come into his hands within a very short time, and would in the usual course have been demanded from him at the beginning of June.

It had been the custom for years past to make the District Constable stationed at Jerusalem the recipient of Office Fees, which were ordinarily of small amount. The present Resident Magistrate of Richmond did not deem it necessary, on assuming charge of the District, to interfere with an arrangement which had, up to that time, worked satisfactorily; but since this defalcation took place it has been decided that all Dog Licences shall be issued at Richmond, which will now leave only very small sums to be collected during a month at the Out-station of Jerusalem.
