

# GOVERNMENT DOMAIN.

#### REPORT FROM THE SELECT COMMITTEE.

Brought up by Mr. Dunn, and ordered by the House to be printed, 4 June, 1857.



REPORT of the SELECT COMMITTEE appointed to consider the Petition from certain Inhabitants of Hobart Town, praying that the Government Domain may be vested in the City Corporation for the use and recreation of the Inhabitants of Hobart Town.

Your Committee are of opinion that it is most desirable that the Domain should be set apart for the use and recreation of the people; and considering the lateness of the Session, and wishing to have the prayer of the Petitioners effected with as little delay as possible, have come to the following Resolutions :---

lst. That, in the opinion of this Committee, the Domain should be reserved for the use of the Citizens of Hobart Town.

2nd. That, in the opinion of this Committee, the Domain should be vested in Trustees, to hold it in trust for ever for the benefit of the Citizens of Hobart Town; the Trustees to consist of—

> The Colonial Secretary, The Colonial Treasurer, The Mayor of Hobart Town,

3rd. That it would be desirable that the Report of your Committee, if adopted by your Honourable House, should be conveyed to the Government, in order to prevent the alienation of any portion of the Domain before the next Session of Parliament.

4th. That your Committee are of opinion that a Bill should be introduced into your Honourable House early in the next Session of Parliament to carry out the recommendations of the Committee.
