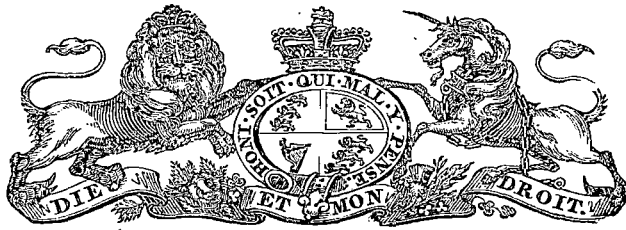

PARLIAMENT OF TASMANIA.

EXPENDITURE ON PORTS OF HOBART,
LAUNCESTON, AND DEVONPORT.

Return to an Order of the Legislative Council. (Mr. M'Gregor.)

Ordered by the Legislative Council to be printed, November 2, 1893.



Ordered, That there be laid on the Table of this Council a Return showing, separately, the amount of money voted by Parliament since the Year 1883, inclusive, for Improvements and new Works :—(1) In the River Tamar and Port of Launceston; (2) In the River Mersey and Port of Devonport; (3) In the Port of Hobart. The Return to specify separately the amounts, if any, granted as Subsidies or Loans during the same periods to the Marine Boards having control of the above-mentioned Ports. (*Mr. M'Gregor.*)
