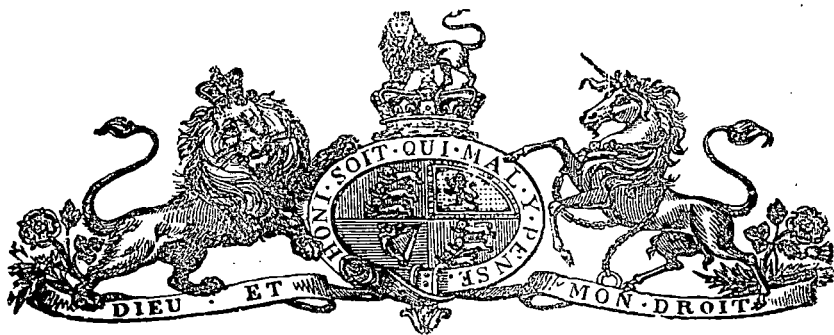

SIR,

I HAVE the honor to forward Returns connected with the Hobart Public Cemetery for the year ended 31st December, 1881.

The number of deaths in the Hobart Registration District during 1881 was 627, being a decrease of 21 as compared with 1880.

The receipts from interments were £685 6s. 8d., an increase of £94 12s. 8d. over the previous year.

The Trustees have nothing of any special importance to report in connection with the past year.
