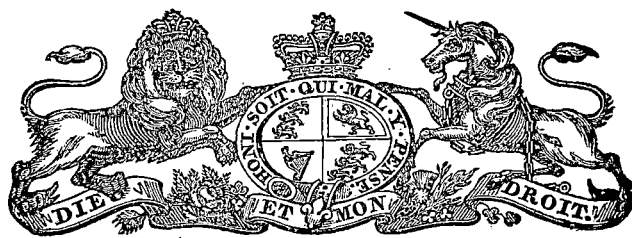

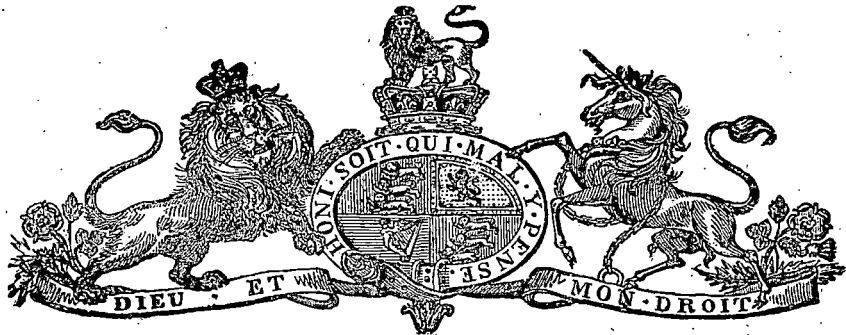

ANNUAL REPORT of the TASMANIAN COUNCIL OF EDUCATION for the Year 1877-8.

To His Excellency FREDERICK ALOYSIUS WELD, Esquire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Tasmania and its Dependencies.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY.

1. In conformity with the provisions of "The Tasmanian Council of Education and Scholarship Act," we have the honor to submit this our Eighteenth Report of the proceedings of the Council from the 1st May, 1877, to the 30th April, 1878. 22 Vict. No. 21, Section 30.

2. The Rev. R. D. Poulett-Harris was re-elected President for the year ending 30th June, 1878. President.

3. We caused an Examination of Candidates for the Council of Education Exhibitions to be held in the month of June, 1877. Nine Students presented themselves for examination; and, on the recommendation of the Examiners, Exhibitions of the annual value of £20 each for four years were awarded to Percy Leslie Waterhouse, pupil of W. W. Fox, Esq., B.A., Horton College, Ross, and Claude William Rock, pupil of the Rev. W. H. Savigny, M.A., Church Grammar School, Launceston. Two others obtained a standard of marks sufficient to entitle them to an Exhibition. Council of Education Exhibitions, Gazette Notice, 26th June, 1877.

The Examiners in closing their Report observe:—

"We are of opinion that the results of the Examination are very satisfactory, the average merit of Candidates being considerably greater than last year, and the attainments of the two foremost especially being in a high degree creditable both to themselves and to the schools which they represent."

4. The Eighteenth Examination for the Degree of Associate of Arts was held in September, 1877; the Rev. J. E. Bromby, D.D., Melbourne, being Examiner in English, Latin, Greek, Pure Mathematics, and Natural Philosophy; the Hon. F. S. Dobson, M.A., L.L.D., Examiner in French and German; Professor Charles H. Pearson, M.A., Ladies' College, Melbourne, Examiner in Italian; and Mr. Henry Hunter, Examiner in Drawing. Eighteen Candidates under nineteen years of age presented themselves; sixteen passed the Preliminary Examination, and fifteen succeeded in obtaining the Degree: ten being placed in the First Class, and five in the Second Class. Degree of Associate of Arts, Gazette Notice, 23rd October, 1877.

5. Two Candidates over nineteen years of age presented themselves for examination, each obtaining a Third Class Degree.

6. George Alexander Webster, as Senior Associate of the year, received the Council's Gold Medal and the First Prizes for Latin and Mathematics, a Second Prize for Greek, and a Prize for Natural Philosophy. To Stephen Henry Hughes, who was placed in the First Class, was awarded the Second Prize for English. To William Walker, who was also placed in the First Class, was awarded the First Prize for Italian, and the Second Prize for Mathematics. To Arthur Frederick Davenport, who was also placed in the First Class, was awarded the First Prize for Greek and the Second Prize for Latin. To Leigh Trafford Tarleton, also placed in the First Class, was awarded the Second Prize for French. To Charles Sydney Jones, who was also placed in the First Class, was awarded the First Prize for English. To Alfred Henry Chesterman, who was placed in the Second Class, was awarded the Council's Prize for Drawing; and to Isabel Mary Riddell, who was also placed in the Second Class, was awarded a Prize for French.

“The Examiner-in-Chief has much pleasure in bearing testimony to the large body of knowledge displayed by the Candidates. The English subjects were not so well done as last year; but the Classical and Mathematical ones were executed in a way decidedly superior. Great care is always taken not to lavish marks unless fully earned, and to keep to as exact a standard as possible; and the fact that the highest number ever gained by a Candidate has been scored this year, of itself testifies to the high merits of the Candidates who have presented themselves.”

Tasmanian Scholarships, *Gazette* Notice, 23rd October, 1877.

7. The Examination for Tasmanian Scholarships in October last was conducted by the Rev. J. E. Bromby, D.D. Three Candidates presented themselves; two—George Archibald MacMillan, A.A., 1875, and Neil Elliot Lewis, A.A., 1875,—reached the standard prescribed by the Council. A Scholarship was awarded to each, and they have since proceeded to Great Britain to enter upon their University studies.

Scholars.

8. Of the progress of the Tasmanian Scholars we learn that G. W. Waterhouse, Tasmanian Scholar of 1873, was admitted to the Degree of B.A., University of Cambridge, in January last, and that his name appears as a Wrangler in the Honor List of the year. C. C. Williamson, Tasmanian Scholar of the same year, was admitted to the Degree of B.A., Cambridge, and passed with credit in the Legal Tripos. A. P. Canaway, Tasmanian Scholar of 1875, has taken a Second Class in Moderations at Oxford; and H. B. Barrett, Tasmanian Scholar of 1876, has passed his Little-go at Cambridge.

Dry Scholarship.

9. The Dry Scholarship was awarded to George Alexander Webster, the senior Associate of the year, he having intimated his intention to proceed with his studies and compete for a Tasmanian Scholarship.

Gilchrist Scholarship.

10. Arrangements were made for holding the fourth examination for the Scholarship offered to the youth of this Colony by the Trustees of “The Gilchrist Educational Trust.” Two students announced their intention to compete, but neither presented themselves for examination.

Local Examination for Matriculation at Melbourne University.

11. Since the publication of our last Report, two examinations of Candidates for matriculation at the University of Melbourne have been held in Hobart Town, under our supervision, with the following result:—End of February term, 1877.—One Candidate; failed. October term, 1877.—Eight Candidates; two failed. William Walker, Wm. P. Goddard, and Beatrice Mary Pike passed both the Matriculation and Civil Service Examinations; the first-named passing with “credit.” Leigh T. Tarleton passed the Matriculation Examination; and Philip M. Pitt and W. J. Matthews, though failing in the Matriculation Examination, succeeded in passing the Civil Service Examination.

Mr. C. J. Pike, A.A.

12. A letter was received from the Government in February last, notifying that the Legislature of Tasmania had authorised the payment of £400 to Mr. C. J. Pike, A.A., of 1873, as a reward for his distinguished position at the 1875 Examination for the Tasmanian Scholarship.

Vacancy in Council.

13. A vacancy has been created in the Council by the retirement of the Rev. W. W. Spicer, M.A., F.R.S. The vacancy has been filled by the election of the Hon. W. R. Giblin.

14. We submit a Statement of the Disbursements of the Council between the 1st Financial Statement. January and the 31st December, 1877, the termination of the financial year; together with a Supplementary Statement of Payments between the 1st January and the 30th April, 1878. The total expenditure under every head for the year 1877 is shown to have amounted to £2172 8s. 9d.

15. We append to our Report a Roll of the Tasmanian Scholars, a List of those Appendix A. Students who have obtained the Degree of Associate of Arts, and a List of those who B, and C. obtained Exhibitions offered by the Council.
