

## TASMANIAN COUNCIL OF EDUCATION:

REPORT FOR 1876-7.

Laid upon the Table by Mr. Crowther, and ordered by the Council to be printed, July 13, 1877.



ANNUAL REPORT of the Tasmanian Council of Education for the Year 1876-7.

To His Excellency Frederick Aloysius Weld, Esquire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Tasmania and its Dependencies.

#### MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY.

- 1. In conformity with the provisions of "The Tasmanian Council of Education and 22 Vict. No. Scholarship Act," we have the honor to submit this our Seventeenth Report of the 21, Section 30. proceedings of the Council between the 1st May, 1876, and the 30th April, 1877.
- 2. The Rev. R. D. Poulett-Harris was elected President for the year ending 30th President. June, 1877.
- 3. We caused an Examination of Candidates for the Council of Education Exhibitions to be held in the month of June, 1876. Sixteen Students presented themselves for examination; one was rejected at the preliminary Examination, and on the recommendation of the Examiners, Exhibitions of the annual value of £20 each for four years were Notice, 27th awarded to Allan John Baxter, pupil of the Rev. W. H. Savigny, M.A., Church Gram-June, 1876.

4. The Nineteenth Examination for the Degree of Associate of Arts was held in Degree of September, 1876; the Rev. J. E. Bromby, D.D., Melbourne, being Examiner in Associate of English, Latin, Greek, Pure Mathematics, Natural Philosophy, and Geology; the Hon. Arts, Gazette Notice, 10th F. S. Dobson, M.A., LL.D., Examiner in French and German; Professor Charles H. October, 1876. Pearson, M.A., Ladies College, Melbourne, Examiner in Italian; and Mr. Henry Hunter, Examiner in Drawing. Eighteen Candidates under nineteen years of age presented themselves; all passed the Preliminary Examination, and fourteen succeeded in obtaining the Degree: eight being placed in the First Class, three in the Second Class, and three in the Third Class.

One Candidate over nineteen years of age presented herself for examination, and succeeded in obtaining a First Class Degree.

5. Evans John Taylor, as Senior Associate of the year, received the Council's Gold Medal, First Prize for Greek, and Second Prizes for English and Italian. To Philip Oakley Fysh, who was placed in the First Class, was awarded the Second Prize for French. To Philip Mackenzie Pitt, who was also placed in the First Class, was awarded the First Prize for Mathematics. To Harold Banks Smith, who was also placed in the First Class, were awarded First Prizes for Latin and for Greek. To George Quinlan Roberts, who was also placed in the First Class, were awarded Second Prize for Mathematics, and a prize for Natural Philips for Italian and Second Prize for Mathematics, and Second Pri who was also placed in the First Class, were awarded First Prize for Italian and Second Prize for German. To Maud Marion Maxwell, who was also placed in the First Class, were awarded First Prizes for English, French, and German.

The Examiners in closing their Report observe:-

"The Examiner in Chief is of opinion that the merits of the Candidates have not this year at all fallen below that of the previous one. The same amount of general diligence and ability has been displayed, and within 54 the same average marks obtained out of three or four thousand."

Tasmanian Scholarships, Gazette Notice, 10th Oct. 1876. 6. The Examination for Tasmanian Scholarships in September last was conducted by the Rev. J. E. Bromby, D.D. Five Candidates presented themselves; two—William Harvey Buckland, A.A. 1874, and Herbert Burgess Barrett, A.A. 1874,—reached the standard prescribed by the Council. A Scholarship was awarded to each, and they have since proceeded to Great Britian to enter upon their University studies.

Dry Scholarship. 7. The Dry Scholarship having been declined by the Senior Associate, and by the three next Associates of the year, was awarded to George Quinlan Roberts, First Class Associate of Arts, 1876, he having intimated his intention to proceed with his studies and compete for a Tasmanian Scholarship.

Local examination for Matriculation at Melbourne University.

8. Since the publication of our last Report two Examinations of Candidates for Matriculation at the University of Melbourne, have been held in Hobart Town under our supervision. Of the Candidates who presented themselves, the following have passed:—

Extra February term, 1876—Algernon Townsend Creswell, Hutchins' School. October term, 1876—William Henry Cutts, Horton College.

Exhibitions.

9. F. W. S. Allison, E. J. Taylor, and Edwin Maxey, having resigned their Exhibitions, dating respectively 1873, 1874, and 1875, the same have been conferred upon G. Q. Roberts, C. J. Buscombe, and Hugh M. Prior for the unexpired periods.

Scholars.

10. We have to record that J. W. H. Geiss, Tasmanian Scholar of 1871, graduated a B.A. in March, 1876, at Oxford.

London University Mutriculation Examination. 11. In December last we forwarded a communication to Dr. Carpenter, Registrar of the London University, intimating that we would be happy to undertake the supervision of the June Matriculation Examination in each year for Students in this Colony, if the Senate of the University were pleased to sanction such an arrangement. Up to the present time no reply has been received.

Vacancies.

12. We have to record that, through the operation of Section 9 of our Regulations, the seats of the Honorable Sir Robert Officer, the Right Rev. Bishop Murphy, and the Rev. Canon Hudspeth, were rendered vacant. The first named gentleman having consented to continue a member of our body was unanimously re-elected. The other vacancies have been filled by the election of the Rev. W. W. Spicer, M.A., F.R.S., and Philip Turner, Esq., C.B.

A.A. Degree. Additional 13. We have framed the following Rule, to form part of Section 24 of our Regulations respecting the issue of a Certificate to Candidates for the Examination for the

Degree of Associate of Arts who pass in certain subjects, but who fail to obtain the Regulation, Degree, and have duly obtained the approval of Your Excellency in Council thereto:-

Gazette Notice, 10th Oct. 1876.

Candidates who at any Examination for the Degree of Associate of Arts have passed in any number of subjects less than four shall be entitled to receive a Certificate thereof in the following form:

#### CERTIFICATE OF LESS THAN FOUR SUBJECTS.

Whereas by the Regulations of the Tasmanian Council of Education no person is entitled to obtain the Degree of Associate of Arts unless he (or she) has at one and the same Examination passed in four at least of the subjects prescribed for the Examination for the said Degree: and whereas Candidates who at any Examination for the said Degree have passed in any number of subjects less than four are entitled to receive a Certificate thereof: and whereas the Candidate hereinafter named has passed in certain of the said subjects, although not in a sufficient number for obtaining the Degree of Associate of Arts: Now these are to certify that at an Examination for the Degree of Associate of Arts under the Tasmanian Council of Education held in
