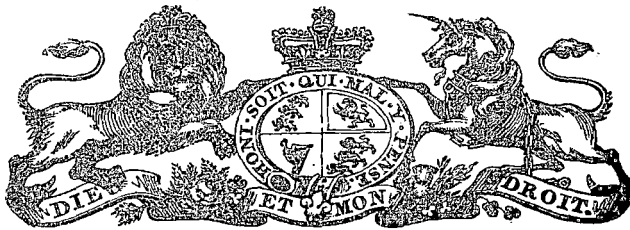

PARLIAMENT OF TASMANIA.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE DEPUTY GOVERNOR
(THE CHIEF JUSTICE):

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by His Excellency's Command.



*By His Excellency SIR ROBERT GEORGE CROOKSHANK HAMILTON
Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath
Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of
Tasmania and its Dependencies.*

WHEREAS by Letters Patent passed under the Great Seal of the United Kingdom constituting the Office of Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Tasmania and its Dependencies and bearing date the seventeenth day of June in the Forty-third year of the reign of Her present Majesty it is provided (amongst other things) that in the event of the Governor having occasion to be temporarily absent for a short period from the Colony he may in every such case by an Instrument under the Public Seal of the Colony constitute Her Majesty's Lieutenant-Governor or if there be no such Officer then any other person to be his Deputy during such temporary absence and in that capacity to exercise perform and execute for and on behalf of the Governor during such absence but no longer all such powers and authorities vested in the Governor by the said Letters Patent as shall in and by such Instrument be specified and limited but no others And whereas there is no Lieutenant-Governor of the said Colony and its Dependencies And whereas I SIR ROBERT GEORGE CROOKSHANK HAMILTON Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Tasmania and its Dependencies have occasion to be temporarily absent for a short period from the said Colony and its Dependencies Now therefore I the said SIR ROBERT GEORGE CROOKSHANK HAMILTON Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath Governor and Commander-in-Chief as aforesaid in exercise of the power vested in me by the said Letters Patent do by this Instrument under the Seal of the said Colony constitute and appoint the Honorable SIR WILLIAM LAMBERT DOBSON Knight Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Tasmania to be my Deputy during my temporary absence as aforesaid and in that capacity to exercise perform and execute for me and on my behalf during such absence but no longer all the powers vested in me by the said Letters Patent save and except the power to dissolve the House of Assembly of Tasmania.

one thousand eight hundred and ninety.
