REPORT.

THE Standing Committee on Public Accounts has the honour to submit the following report to the favourable consideration of your Honourable House:—

HUON MUNICIPALITY LOAN.

This was an application for a loan of £2500 for the purpose of lighting the district of Castle Forbes Bay and the reticulation of the scheme. After considering reports and estimates of the Hydro-Electric Department and Mr. C. B. Davies, consulting engineer, it was resolved to recommend the granting of the proposed loan, with a sinking fund of 2 per cent.

STRAHAN MUNICIPALITY LOAN.

This was an application for a loan of £150 for the purpose of purchasing a recreation ground. After giving the case full consideration the Committee resolved to recommend that the application be deferred until a later date.
