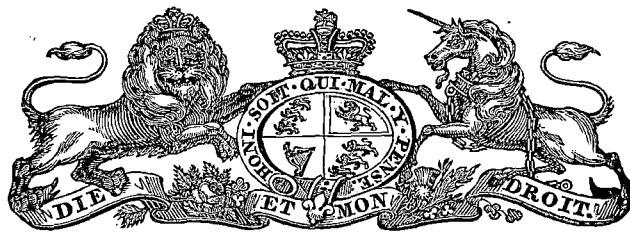

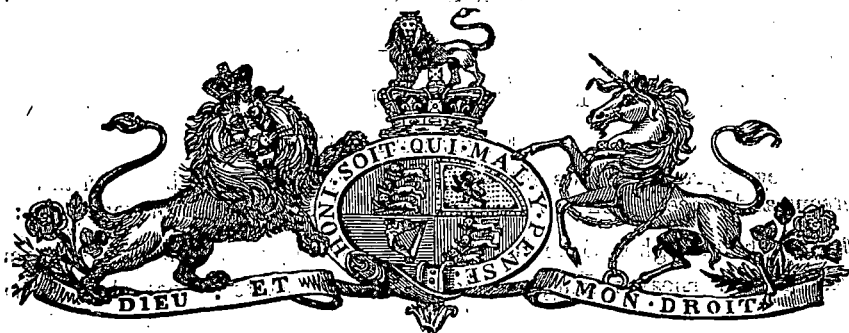

**MONDAY, NOVEMBER 29, 1886.**

The Administrator approves of a Retiring Allowance at the rate of £16 13s. 4d. per annum being granted to Mrs. Susan M'Creary, Schoolmistress, State School, Longford.

To take effect on 1st January next: the amount to be placed upon a Supplementary Estimate.

**MONDAY, JANUARY 31, 1887.**
