



PARLIAMENT OF TASMANIA.

POST OFFICE DEPARTMENT:

REPORT FOR 1892.

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by His Excellency's Command.



GENERAL POST OFFICE:

Hobart, 12th June, 1893.

SIR,

I HAVE the honor to place before you a Report on the Post Office Department of Tasmania for the year 1892, shewing its receipts and expenditure and the general working of its several branches.

Revenue.—The amount collected under this head was £54,736 7s. 4d., thus apportioned:—Postage, £41,798 4s. 8d.; impressed stamps, £9000; money order commission, £2249 15s. 5d.; profit earned under item Savings' Banks, £1042 6s. 5d. (this included £305 8s. 9d., balance of accrued interest to 31st December, 1892); private boxes, mail bags, fines, &c., £598 10s. 1d.; poundage on Postal notes, £47 10s. 9d. It will be seen that there is a decrease of £1727 4s. 7d. on previous year.

The number of stamps sold were:—Adhesive, 6,186,462; post cards, 179,745; embossed envelopes, 3876; registration envelopes, 3680; and impressed,—valued at £9693 19s 2d. 21,386 exchanges were made, representing £305 0s. 9d. This latter amount did not enhance the Revenue, and was a decrease on previous year 1891, being unusually large owing to reasons explained in my last Report.

The above shows a falling off in the aggregate of stamps, post cards, and embossed envelopes of 30,633.

There was also collected £1116 0s. 8d. on account of Customs dues on 6605 packets and parcels valued at £7941 6s. 10d., which passed through the Office as mail matter, which amount went to credit of Customs Department. The amount collected was somewhat less than in previous year, but number of packets was greater and valued at a higher amount. This seeming anomaly is explained by the fact of dutiable packets which did not come to hand through the parcels post being for the first time taken into account in 1892, although duty had always been collected on them, and further by large percentage of packets not producing One Shilling duty which are passed free.

Expenditure.—The expenditure amounted to £54,025 10s. 5d., made up of salaries and allowances, £21,418 13s. 10d.; conveyance of mails, £28,429 18s. 5d.; Miscellaneous, £971 7s. 5d.; stationery and stores, &c., £3205 10s.. 9d.;—against £50,277 7s. 4d. for 1891.

Mail Matter.—Under this head 4,216,289 inland letters were despatched, an increase of 161,958 on previous year; 1,680,872 ship letters received and despatched, an increase of 46,569; 166,387 post cards, or 2640 more than in 1891; 1,212,122 packets were dealt with; and it is estimated that 4,692,676 newspapers passed through the Office. Of these letters and packets 986,152 were franked, and consequently did not contribute to the revenue. This was a diminution in the number of packets dealt with, and also of newspapers; the latter was possibly owing to the tariff levied on papers to countries of the Union outside the Australasian Colonies.

Dead Letter Branch.—34,004 unclaimed letters were disposed of, inclusive of some 3000 "special request," an increase of some 2000 over 1891 returns.

Post Offices.—Seventeen additional offices were established ; the number at close of year being 345 as against 328 at the beginning. The following were the Offices opened :—Pelham, Chudleigh Junction, York Plains, Osterly, Highthorpe, Oyster Cove, Oakwood, A. & E. Store, New Norfolk, North Franklin, West Pine Road, Argenton, King Island, Macquarie Plains Station, Runnymede, West Hobart, S.O., (two), and Ring River.

Number of Miles of Post Roads.—At end of year, $2940\frac{1}{2}$; and 1,421,841 miles were travelled during the year. These figures have been carefully revised.

Inland Mail Service.—A considerable saving was effected in the different services by notifying persons who had indefinite contracts of their cessation, and calling for fresh tenders. Arrangements have been made by which all contracts now in existence will terminate on 31st December, 1894, by which still further reductions may be anticipated. Contractors gave Department very little trouble during the year.

New Mail Services—The following mail services were established during the year :—Strahan and Zeehan, Bellerive and Sorell, per Railway ; increase for bi-weekly service, Launceston and Lefroy ; increase for bi-weekly service, Launceston and George Town *via* Lefroy ; second mail per diem, Hobart and Franklin ; extra mails per diem, East and West Devonport ; Upper Broad Marsh and Hollow Tree ; Post Office, Bellerive, and Railway Station ; Post Office, Sorell, and Railway Station ; Post Office and Railway Station, Zeehan ; Trains and Post Office, Campania ; Coach and Post Office, Longley ; Railway Station and Post Office, Cambridge ; Trains and Post Office, Glenorchy ; Trains and Post Office, Waratah, Dundas, and Ring River.

Intercolonial Mail Service.—This service was very satisfactorily performed, and was generally appreciated.

Money Orders.—During the year 90,640 orders, for £200,882 4s. 3d., were issued ; 73,334, for £157,469 13s. 4d. were paid ; the commission collected on issues was £2555 4s. 6d. On the 1st April an alteration in the rates of Commission on intercolonial orders took place, thereby allowing smaller amounts to be sent at cheaper rates. There was a decrease both in the number of orders issued and paid as well as in the amounts of each. There was also less commission collected.

Post Office Savings Banks—£78,863 0s. 4d. was received as deposit during the year, and £2653 10s. 5d. was apportioned to depositors as interest. £79,363 0s. 11d. was withdrawn, leaving a balance of £83,522 4s. to credit of investors, against £81,368 14s. 2d. at close of previous year. There was an increase in deposits, and a larger amount of interest was devoted to depositors than in 1891. A very considerable increase in amount was withdrawn.

Postal Notes.—10,553 were sold, aggregating £3370 6s. 3d. in amount ; a good increase on previous year.

Inspection.—In my last Report I drew attention to the great need there was for an Inspector, and mentioned that one had been appointed. I am happy to say that he has done good service for the Department.

I regret that my Report does not give a more flourishing state of affairs, the year 1892 being the first year since 1871 (21 years) which shows a decrease in revenue on the previous year.

In conclusion I may add that I have lately returned from attending a Conference held at Brisbane, where matters affecting the internal working of the Post and Telegraph Departments were very fully discussed on Universal Postal Union lines, and trust and believe that the labour of the Delegates at such Conference will bear fruit in the near future.
