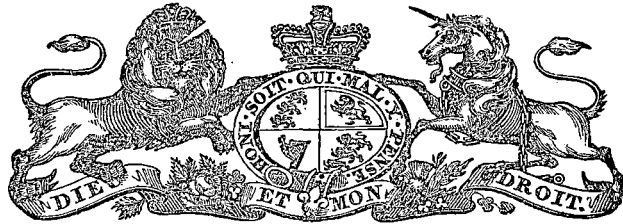

The humble Petition of the undersigned Inhabitants of Hobart Town.

SHOWETH :

THAT your Petitioners have long been convinced that the union of Protestants and Roman Catholics in the Queen's Asylum has been the occasion of painful misunderstandings and serious disadvantages ; and cannot be continued either with that harmony which is essential to the success and prosperity of the Institution, or with that advantage to the children which might otherwise be realized.

Your Petitioners therefore humbly pray your Honorable House to adopt such measures as may be necessary to separate the Protestant and Roman Catholic Children in the Queen's Asylum, so that more perfect and unrestrained freedom may be obtained in training and educating them.

And your Petitioners will ever pray, &c.
