To the Honourable the House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled.

That your Petitioners would gladly pay such Assessments or Rates as might from time to time be made and levied under the provisions of the said Corporation Act, for the privilege of being included within the City boundaries, and enjoying the benefits thereof.

Your Petitioners therefore humbly pray that your Honorable House will take these premises into consideration, and extend the boundaries of the City in the said proposed Bill to Stoke-street, at New Town aforesaid, instead of adopting the boundaries as now proposed.
