

### LAUNCESTON FIRE BRIGADE BOARD.

REPORT of Launceston Fire Brigade Board for Year ending 31st December, 1895.

To the Right Honorable Viscount Gormanston; Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Tasmania and its Dependencies.

#### MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY:

In pursuance of "The Fire Brigades Act," 47 Vict. No. 21, this Board has the honor to report as follows:—

- 1. The Brigade has maintained its full complement of officers and men, who have attended fires, alarms, and practices as required, and have exhibited the usual efficiency in the duties demanded of them.
  - 2. The Superintendent reports that the plant now in use is in a serviceable condition.
- 3. The number of fires and alarms attended by the Brigade during the year was thirty-nine, as per annexed Report.
- 4. The Expenditure for the year was £751 16s. 1d., less amounts unclaimed and expenses paid by the owners and occupiers of uninsured property, £20 5s., leaving the net expenditure £731 11s. 1d.
  - 5. There have been eleven meetings of the Board during the year.
