

ANNUAL REPORT of the Tasmanian Council of Education for the Year 1881-2.

To His Excellency Sir George Cumine Strahan, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Administrator of the Government of the Colony of Tasmania and its Dependencies.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY.

- 1. In conformity with the provisions of "The Tasmanian Council of Education and 22 Vict. No.21, Scholarship Act," we have the honor to submit this our Twenty-second Report of the Section 30. proceedings of the Council from 1st May, 1881, to 30th April, 1882.
- 2. The Hon. Henry Butler was elected President for the year ending 30th June, President. 1882.
- 3. The Annual Examination of Candidates for the Council of Education Exhibitions Council of was held in the month of June, 1881. Nine Students presented themselves for examination; and, on the recommendation of the Examiners, Exhibitions of the annual value of £20 each for four years were awarded to James Edward Miles Roche, pupil of Rev. Notice, 12th R. D. Poulett-Harris, M.A., High School, Hobart, and John Roberts Allport, pupil of July, 1881. W. W. Fox, Esq., B.A., Horton College, Ross. One other obtained a standard of marks sufficient to entitle him to an Exhibition.

We have much pleasure in stating that the recommendation contained in our former report for extending the benefits conferred by these Exhibitions has received the favourable support of Parliament, and provision has been made on the Estimates for 1882 enabling the Council to offer five Exhibitions annually instead of two as heretofore. These Exhibitions are now thrown open to male and female students, under 14 years of age, on equal terms.

4. The twenty-second examination for the Degree of Associate of Arts was held in Degree of December, 1881; the Rev. J. E. Bromby, D.D., Melbourne, being Examiner in English, Associate of Latin, Greek, Pure Mathematics, Natural Philosophy, Chemistry, and Geology; Alfred Notice, 20th Doran, Esq., B.A., Examiner in History and Geography, and French; the Rev. Thomas Dec., 1881.

Kelsh, Examiner in Italian; J. A. Jackson, Esq., B.A., Examiner in German; Henry Hunter, Esq., Examiner in Drawing; and J. Summers, Esq., Examiner in Music.

Seventeen Candidates under nineteen years of age presented themselves; sixteen passed the Preliminary Examination and fifteen succeeded in obtaining the Degree — nine being the Preliminary Examination, and fifteen succeeded in obtaining the Degree, -nine being placed in the First Class, four in the Second Class, and two in the Third Class.

5. James Harcourt Smith, as Senior Associate of the year, received the Council's Gold Medal. He also gained the First Prize for Mathematics, Second Prize for French, Associates who were placed in the First Class, as follows:—Roland James Pope, First Prize for Greek; John Joseph Machamara, Second Prize for Greek; Walter Henry Reed, Second Prizes for English and for Mathematics, and Prizes for Chemistry and Geology. Prizes were awarded to the Associates who gained a Second Class, as follows:—Emily Jane White, awarded Council's Silver Medal as Senior Female Associate of the year; also a Special Prize for English, for French, and for Italian. Sarah Jane Ivey, who was placed in the Third Class, gained a Prize for Drawing.

The Examiner-in-Chief in his Report observes:-

"The Examination this year has not been so brilliant in results as in some former years; but there were a few features which gave great satisfaction, especially in the Mathematical and Scientific schools. One occurrence was the occasion of much regret, viz., that a Candidate lost the whole of her Latin marks by an apparent misapprehension. In order to discourage a mere smattering of knowledge, no marks are allowed in any subject unless they reach a certain standard; and the Candidate in question by neglecting the whole of one Latin paper, which could hardly have failed to produce the requisite number of marks, lost in consequence her position in the First Class."

Tasmanian Scholarships, Gazette Notice, 20th Dec., 1881. 6. The Examination for Tasmanian Scholarships in December last was conducted by the Rev. J. E. Bromby, D.D., assisted by A. Doran, Esq., B.A. Three Candidates presented themselves; two, Claude William Rock, A.A., 1879, and Frederick Lodge, A.A., 1878, reached the standard prescribed by the Council. A Scholarship was awarded to each of them, and they have since proceeded to Great Britain to enter upon their University studies. The remaining Candidate, Charles Seymour Dowdell, came within the limits of eligibility to a Scholarship.

Scholars' progress.

7. We have much pleasure in announcing that Mr. George Archibald Macmillan, Tasmanian Scholar of 1877, took his B.A. Degree in March last at Cambridge, gaining a Third Class in the Honor List; he is now on his way to the Colony. Mr. Neil Elliott Lewis, Tasmanian Scholar of the same year, obtained his B.A. Degree in December last at Oxford, attaining a position in the Third Class Honor List; he is now reading for a Law Examination. Mr. Herbert Burgess Barrett, Tasmanian Scholar of 1876, has recently returned to the Colonies, having been previously called to the Bar in England. Mr. J. G. Lindsay, Tasmanian Scholar of 1878, has been reading for his Tripos Examination, which was to have taken place in the last week in May; he has probably taken his Degree of B.A. ere this: he purposes keeping Terms in the Inner Temple. Mr. G. Q. Roberts, Tasmanian Scholar of the same year, has obtained a Mathematical Third Class in Moderations, Michaelmas Term, 1880, and is studying for his final examination. Mr. G. A. Webster, Tasmanian Scholar of 1879, successfully passed his first M.B. Examination, and is still pursuing his studies for the Medical Profession. Mr. J. S. Clemons, Tasmanian Scholar of 1880, has lately passed Collections creditably, and is now working on for Moderations. Mr. J. Warnock, Tasmanian Scholar of the same year, is close at his studies preparing for his examination in Medicine in October next.

Since our last Report, Messrs. J. W. Tibbs and Francis L. Butler, Tasmanian Scholars of 1874, and Messrs. A. P. Canaway and A. Doran, Scholars of 1875, have returned to Tasmania.

Minor Scholarships. 8. The two Minor Scholarships at the disposal of the Council for this year have been awarded to James Harcourt Smith and John James Macnamara, they having intimated their intention to study and compete for a Tasmanian Scholarship. These Scholarships are each of the value of £40 per annum, and are tenable for two years.

Dry Scholarship. 9. The Dry Scholarship was awarded to James Harcourt Smith, Senior Associate of the year, he having announced his intention of studying for the Tasmanian Scholarship Examination.

10. Since the publication of our last Report two examinations of candidates for Local Exami-Matriculation at the University of Melbourne have been held in Hobart under our nation for Matriculation supervision, with the following results:—2nd February Term, 1881—Five Candidates. at Melbourne Three failed. Two, viz., Walter Henry Reed and Ralf Stephenson, passed the University. Matriculation Examination, the former passing with credit. October Term, 1881—Two Candidates, viz., Arthur Herbert Davis and Eustace Lyndon Smith, passed both the Matriculation and the Civil Service Examination.

11. We submit a Statement of the Disbursements of the Council between the 1st Financial Statement. January and the 31st December, 1881, the termination of the financial year, together with a Supplementary Statement of Payments between the 1st January and the 30th April, 1882. The total expenditure under every head for the year 1881 is shown to have amounted to £1964 ls. 10d.

12. We append to our Report a Roll of the Tasmanian Scholars, a List of those Appendices Students who have obtained the Degree of Associate of Arts, and a List of those who A, B, and C. obtained Exhibitions offered by the Council.
