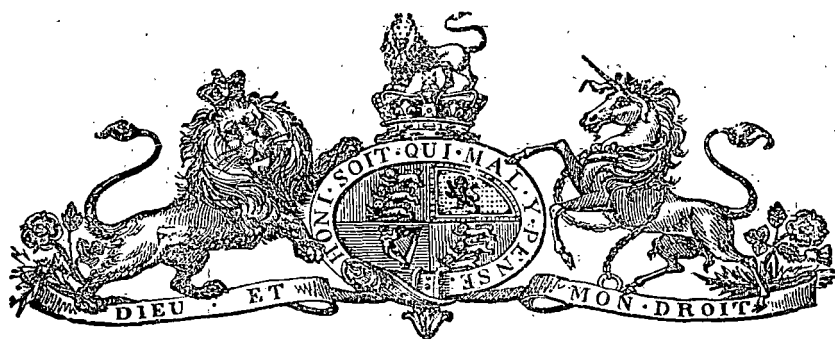

MEMORANDUM.

In addition to the Fees received by the Telegraph Construction and Maintenance Company for Messages transmitted by the Submarine Cable between Tasmania and Victoria, amounting to the sum of £2561 12s. 5d. for the year ending 30th April, 1870, the sum of £4200 was paid by the Tasmanian Government to the Telegraph Construction and Maintenance Company as guaranteed interest on £70,000, the estimated cost of the Submarine Cable.
