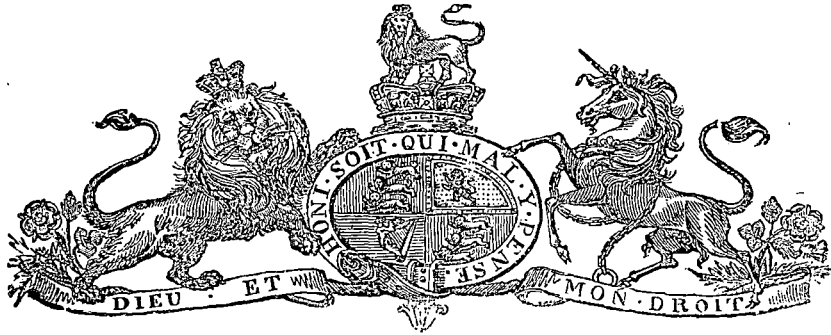

STATE AID REDISTRIBUTION.

PETITION FROM THE REV. DR. BROWNE.

To the Honorable the Legislative Council.

The humble Petition of the undersigned Chaplain, appointed by the Crown, and now ministering under *The Church Act*.

SHOWETH :

THAT your Petitioner lost heavily some years ago through mistakes by which his Salary was paid to the account of other persons in place of to Petitioner, and never could get reimbursed.

That Petitioner, therefore prays that, in any measure which may be passed for effecting redistribution, his present direct relation to the Crown may continue undisturbed ; and that so long as he may retain his Chaplaincy he may be paid from the Colonial Treasury, and not through any body or individual not responsible to Petitioner.
