

Note.—The Buildings had to be, to a great extent, gutted; partition Walls removed and new ones erected; floorings removed and relaid; new Stores erected, also new Outbuildings, Sheds, Messenger's Quarters, and Closets, roofs reshingled, chimneys rebuilt, and walls cemented. The whole interior and exterior had to undergo thorough alteration and repair; new drains had, to a considerable extent, to be laid, also, a drain of large size around the Building.
