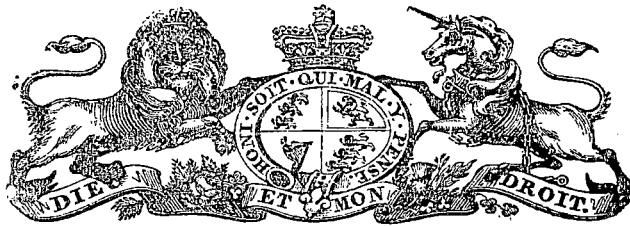

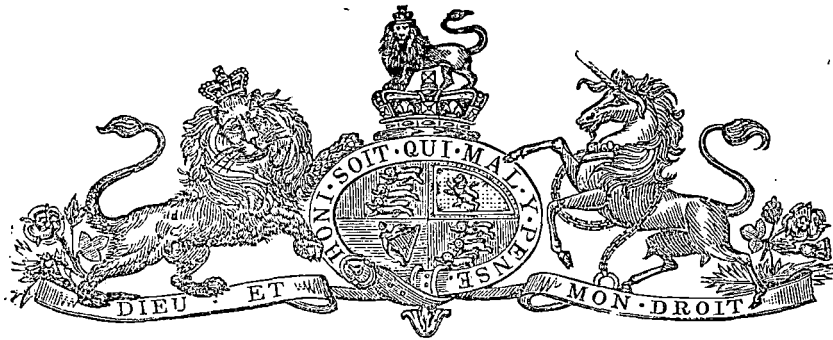

The humble Petition of the undersigned Adult Residents in the Colony of Tasmania,

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH :

THAT your Petitioners are desirous that Women should, as a bare act of justice, have the same privilege of electing Members to both Houses of Parliament as is enjoyed by Men.

Your Petitioners, therefore, respectfully pray that your Honorable House will pass a Law granting that privilege to Women.
