



## BYE-LAW No. 10.

BYE-LAW made by the Circular Head Marine Board under and by virtue of the Acts of the Parliament of Tasmania, 21st Victoria, No. 16, and 31st Victoria, No. 30:—

Wharfage Rates from and after the 5th day of August, 1879.

The fees payable in respect of the landing of Bricks and Clay Drain-pipes to be as follows, so imported into the country, anything before contained to the contrary notwith-standing:—

Bricks, Five Shillings per 1000. Clay Drain-pipes, assorted, One Shilling and Eight Pence per ton of 2240 lbs.

Made and passed by the Circular Head Marine Board, this 5th day of August, 1879, when a majority of the Members were present.
