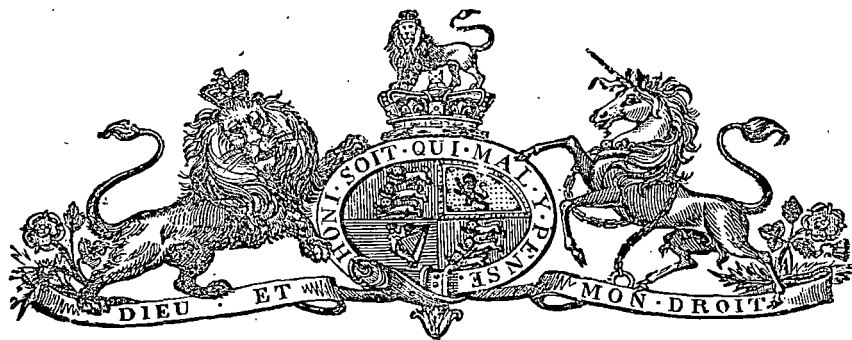

REPORT of the CAMPBELL TOWN HOSPITAL, 1870.

THE Trustees in submitting this Report beg first to state that, in consequence of the shortness of time, and nothing of importance having happened since the meeting held in July, 1869, they considered it not necessary to call a meeting at the end of that year, consequently this Report embraces the transactions of the last eighteen months.

We have much pleasure in reporting the continued usefulness of the Institution. There have been 65 cases treated with Dr. Valentine's usual care and attention. The number of deaths has been 9. The duties of the Master and Matron have been, as hitherto, performed in a very satisfactory manner; and the Clergy of the District continue to take deep interest in the Patients.

We are reluctantly compelled to state that, although some subscribers are most liberal, many members of the community will not assist to support so valuable an Institution. This applies more particularly to the working classes.

The repairs authorised at the last meeting have been completed, and are found to be a great comfort and benefit.

The Turkish Baths are believed to be of great benefit in some cases; but, owing to the great decrease in the patronage of the general public, do not pay working expenses,—in fact, during the last eighteen months they have been continued at a loss of more than £40.

We would beg to point out that, were it not for the Government aid, the funds of the Hospital would be in a very depressed state,—so much so as to cause much anxiety for the future of the Institution, as subscriptions continue to decline.
