**REPEAL OF REGULATIONS POSTPONEMENT
BILL (No. 2) 2011**

A BILL FOR

**An Act to postpone the repeal of the *Workplace Health and
Safety Regulations 1998***

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by
and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Repeal of
Regulations Postponement Act (No. 2) 2011*.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which this
Act receives the Royal Assent.

3. Postponement of repeal

- (1) The staged repeal of the *Workplace Health and
Safety Regulations 1998* that, but for this section,
was to have been effected on 1 January 2012 is
postponed until 1 January 2013.

(2) Subsection (1) does not prevent the *Workplace Health and Safety Regulations 1998* from being rescinded before 1 January 2013.

(3) In this section –

“staged repeal” in relation to the *Workplace Health and Safety Regulations 1998* means the repeal that was to be effected by section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992* but was postponed under the *Repeal of Regulations Postponement Act 2008*, the *Repeal of Regulations Postponement Act (No. 2) 2009* and the *Repeal of Regulations Postponement Act (No. 2) 2010*.

4. Administration of Act

Until provision is made in relation to this Act by order under section 4 of the *Administrative Arrangements Act 1990* –

- (a) the administration of this Act is assigned to the Minister for Workplace Relations; and
- (b) the department responsible to that Minister in relation to the administration of this Act is the Department of Justice.

5. Expiry

This Act expires on 2 January 2013.
