

UNDER ACT 31 VICT. No. 23.

FOR CONSTRUCTING BRIDGES AND CLEARING TRACKS BETWEEN TABLE CAPE, CIRCULAR HEAD, AND THE DUCK RIVER.

Vоте-£6000.

The clearing of deviations under contract of Messrs. Brown, Swain, and Lennard, referred to in my previous report, has been completed.

The balance on C. B. M. Fenton's contract for works on road from River Inglis to Jacob's Boat Harbour has also been paid.

UNDER ACT 33 VICT. No. 17.

FOR CUTTING TRACKS THROUGH CROWN LANDS, VOTE—£2000.

In addition to the works mentioned in report of 21st June, a track has been marked out by Mr. District Surveyor Sprent from the public road at Moore's Plains, Table Cape, to the Hellyer River, (Gold-Fields,) a distance of about 17 miles; and the tender of Messrs. Dean and Blackwell, at £70, for clearing the line, has been accepted. The work is reported as nearly finished, but has not yet been inspected.

Tracks are also being cut by Mr. District Surveyor Reid in the Fingal district from the reserved road near Harvey's into and through the good land to the north of Mount Nicholas range for a distance of about 5 to 7 miles, at a cost not to exceed £4 per mile.

An exploration track, between the Nicholls Rivulet and the Snug, has been cleared for a few miles, at about £2 per mile, in order to ascertain if a practicable road can be obtained.

On the recommendation of the Visiting Justices the division wall between the yard of the new cells and the old Debtors' yard has been raised to the height of the outer wall. The Sheriff reports that this work, though not absolutely necessary, adds to the security of the building, and makes the arrangements for the safe custody of the prisoners complete.
