**An Act to amend the *Financial Management and Audit Act
1990***

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by
and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Financial
Management and Audit Amendment Act 2010*.

2. Commencement

This Act is taken to have commenced on
16 June 2010.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, the *Financial Management and Audit
Act 1990** is referred to as the Principal Act.

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (e) “*Ombudsman Act 1978.*” and substituting “*Ombudsman Act 1978; or*”;
- (b) by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (e):
 - (f) in the case of an appropriation for the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions, the Minister administering the *Director of Public Prosecutions Act 1973.*
