A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the *Penalty Units and Other Penalties Act 1987*

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Penalty Units and Other Penalties Amendment Act 2011*.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, the *Penalty Units and Other Penalties Act 1987** is referred to as the Principal Act.

4. Section 4A amended (Indexation of penalty units)

Section 4A of the Principal Act is amended as follows:

- (a) by inserting the following subsection after subsection (4):

(4A) An order under subsection (3) is a statutory rule.

- (b) by inserting the following subsection after subsection (7):

(7A) Notwithstanding subsections (3) and (4) –

- (a) the value of a penalty unit for the financial year commencing on 1 July 2010 is taken to be and to have always been \$130; and
- (b) the value of a penalty unit for the financial year commencing on 1 July 2011 is taken to be

and to have always been
\$130.

5. Repeal of Act

This Act is repealed on the ninetieth day from
the day on which it commences.
