## **A BILL FOR**

### **An Act to postpone the repeal of certain regulations**

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

#### **1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *Repeal of Regulations Postponement Act (No. 2) 2012*.

#### **2. Commencement**

This Act commences on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

#### **3. Postponement of repeals**

- (1) The staged repeals of the regulations specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 that, but for this section,

were to have been effected on the respective dates specified in Column 2 of that Schedule are postponed until 1 July 2013.

- (2) Subsection (1) does not prevent any of the regulations specified in Schedule 1 from being rescinded before 1 July 2013.
- (3) In this section –

*staged repeals* means the repeals that were to be effected by section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992* but were postponed under the *Repeal of Regulations Postponement Act 2009* and the *Repeal of Regulations Postponement Act 2010*.

#### **4. Administration of Act**

Until provision is made in relation to this Act by order under section 4 of the *Administrative Arrangements Act 1990* –

- (a) the administration of this Act is assigned to the Minister for Sustainable Transport; and
- (b) the department responsible to that Minister in relation to the administration of this Act is the Department of Infrastructure, Energy and Resources.
