

LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL SELECT COMMITTEE

RECREATIONAL MARINE FISHING IN TASMANIA

TERMS OF REFERENCE

On Tuesday, 4 May 2010 the Legislative Council resolved that a Select Committee, originally appointed on Tuesday 20 November 2007 and re-established on Tuesday, 4 March 2008 to inquire into and report upon Recreational Marine Fishing in Tasmania, be re-established with power to send for persons and papers, with leave to sit during any adjournment of the Council, and with leave to adjourn from place to place, with particular reference to —

- (1) The suitability of the current recreational marine fishing body Tasmanian Association for Recreational Fishing Inc (TARFish);
- (2) The suitability of the current licensing arrangements for recreational marine fishing activities;
- (3) The suitability of the Recreational Fishing Licences Trust Fund (the Fishwise Fund) and the Fishwise Community Grants Program;
- (4) The socio-economic impact on the State;
- (5) The bio-mass sustainability and management; and
- (6) Any other matters incidental thereto.
