INQUIRY INTO INTEGRATED TRANSPORT OPTIONS FOR SOUTHERN TASMANIA

The Legislative Council Inquiry into the integrated transport options for Southern Tasmania will continue this week with public hearings in Hobart on **Wednesday 10 October 2012.**

The Committee has received an overwhelming public response to the inquiry and has heard from a range of stakeholders in relation to the current public transport services provided by Metro Tasmania and the options for an integrated transport network in Southern Tasmania, including the use of light rail, ferries and other transport options.
