I write to outline my opposition to the proposed \$750 million stadium at Macquarie Point.

- 1. The site is totally inappropriate, both from a visual and a traffic management standpoint.
- 2. It is disrespectful to place a large, ugly and totally unrelated building so close to the Hobart Cenotaph.
- 3. There are perfectly good stadia in both Hobart and Launceston, currently used for football, which could if necessary be upgraded for far lower costs. In particular, York Park is much more suitable in terms of accessability, traffic management and setting than Macquarie Point. There is no good argument for a new or upgraded stadium having to be in the capital city.
- 4. The huge cost will incur yet more debt for the government, and hence the people of Tasmania.
- 5. There are far greater needs for government expenditure (health, housing, education) which would benefit all Tasmanians.
