



REPORT of the Board for the Year ending 31st December, 1898.

To the Right Honourable Viscount Gormanston, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Tasmania and its Dependencies.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY:

In pursuance of "The Fire Brigades Act," (47 Vict. No. 21), this Board has the honour to report as follows:—

- 1. During the past year the strength of the Brigade has been increased from 25 to 30 men, including officers, who have attended fires, alarms, and practices as required, and have exhibited the usual efficiency.
 - 2. The plant has been increased, and is in good condition.
 - 3. A Reel-station has been established on the Elphin Road.
- 4. The number of fires and alarms attended by the Brigade during the year was thirty-four, as per Annual Report of the Superintendent herewith.
- 5. The Expenditure for the year amounted to £958 13s. 11d., less unclaimed amounts, £2 2s. 6d., and expenses paid by the owners and occupiers of uninsured property, £4; leaving the net expenditure £952 11s. 5d.
 - 6. There have been thirteen meetings of the Board during the year.
