
HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY.

THE only items which are not included in the proposed and probable Expenditure for the Year 1873 are as follows:—

Electric Telegraph.-Salary of Operator at George Town, at the rate of £26 per annum.

Port Arthur.—Contingencies. It is estimated that an excess of £1727 will be the result of the year's Expenditure under this head.

The estimated Reductions and Savings, by changes and otherwise, for the last Half of the Year 1873, as compared with those for the first Six Months, will be as follows :---
