

RETURN OF EXPENSE IN ALTERATION OF BATTERIES.

Return to an Order of the House. (Mr. Davies.)

Laid upon the Table by the Minister of Lands and Works, and ordered by the House to be printed, November 24, 1871.



RETURN of Expense in Alteration of existing Batteries.

The authority by which any alterations on the existing Batteries of the Colony have been made,

And by which any new Battery or defence work has been constructed, together with the Costs incurred in such alteration and construction.

No authority in this Office for alterations to existing Batteries, and no alterations made by or through Director of Public Works.

By the authority of the Governor in Council, of 13th March, 1871, and 7th August, 1871, approving of £720 to be provided on Supplementary Estimate for the erection of the "Alexandra Battery," One Tree Point. Cost of construction to 30th October, 1871, through Director of Public Works,—vide Parliamentary Return, No. 50—£500 14s. 7d.
