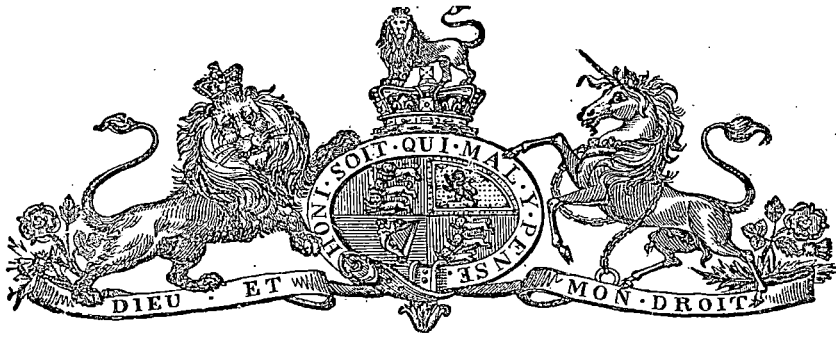

STAMP DUTIES.

PETITION AGAINST ADDITIONAL.

Presented by Mr. Innes, and ordered by the Council to be printed, August 15, 1865.



*To the Honorable the President and Members of the Legislative Council
of Tasmania, in Parliament assembled.*

The humble Petition of the undersigned Merchants, Bankers, and Traders of the City of Hobart
Town.

HUMBLY SHOWETH :

THAT your Petitioners have learned that, towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty for the year 1866, it is the intention of the Government to increase the amount to be raised and collected under *The Stamp Act* by imposing One Penny Duty on every Receipt or Discharge given for or upon the payment of money amounting to Twenty Shillings or upwards, and also the like sum of One Penny on every Draught or Order for the payment of any sum of money to the bearer or to order on demand.

That, although your Petitioners regret the necessity for imposing fresh Duties, still they are desirous to express their readiness cheerfully to contribute to the support of the General Revenue of the Colony so long as the levying of such Duties is based on a principle calculated to secure a fair and equitable distribution of the payment thereof amongst all classes of the community.

That your Petitioners consider the present system of levying Duties under *The Stamp Act* presses too heavily on the Trading portion of the Inhabitants, and compels them to contribute a large proportion to the Revenue of the Country from which other sections of the community are exempt.

That your Petitioners believe that making good the contemplated deficiency in the Revenue by levying the aforesaid Duty of One Penny on the above-mentioned monetary transactions will be in the highest degree burdensome and oppressive to the Trading portion of this community, will tend materially to cramp the operations of Trade, and be productive of such practical inconvenience as the present circumstances of the Colony do not justify; while the sum to be derived therefrom will be so inconsiderable as to be totally inadequate to compensate for the vexatious effects of its operation.

Your Petitioners, therefore, humbly pray that your Honorable House will be pleased to consider the subject matter of this Petition, and make provision for raising the Revenue required for 1866 without imposing additional Duties under *The Stamp Act*.

And your Petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
