



REGULATIONS UNDER "THE MOUNT CAMERON WATER-RACE ACT, 1887."

By virtue of "The Mount Cameron Water-race Act, 1887," His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth make the following Regulation, which shall take effect on and from the twenty-seventh day of August, 1888.

By His Excellency's Command,

5. Regulation No. 5 of the 2nd day of July, 1888, is hereby rescinded, and the following shall stand in lieu thereof:—

Water for mining purposes shall be supplied during the hours from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., which shall be called "Day Water," and during the hours from 4 p.m. to 12 midnight, and from 12 midnight to 8 a.m., which shall be called "Night Water," at the following rates per head per week of six working days of eight hours each; that is to say—

In this Regulation English quoted market price means the price quoted in the newspapers published in Launceston on the Monday next before the delivery of the water.
