



NORTHERN BOARD OF EDUCATION.

[CIRCULAR.]

The Board, having received imperative orders from the Government to make an immediate reduction in its Expenditure, is compelled to notify to Teachers that all Salaries above £50 per annum will be reduced from the 1st January, 1861, according to the following Scales :---

In consideration of the above reduction, Teachers are hereby authorised to charge, in lieu of the existing rate of School Fees, any sum not exceeding 1s. per week for each Child.
