INQUIRY INTO COMPLIANCE WITH THE DEED OF AGREEMENT, SCHEDULE 1 OF THE GAMING CONTROL ACT 1993

TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Standing Committee of Public Accounts has resolved of its own motion to inquire and report upon:

- a) Compliance by Federal Hotels in relation to the commitments in the Deed of Agreement in Schedule I of the Gaming Control Act 1993.
- b) Compliance by Federal Hotels in relation to the evidence provided to the Public Accounts Committee in the course of the Committee's Inquiry into the Deed of Agreement in 2003.
- c) The responsibility of the State Government to keep Parliament (and the people) informed of any variations to the projected timelines and the nature of the development at Coles Bay; and
- d) Any other matters incidental hereto.

Submissions become Committee documents and are made public only after a decision by the Committee. Persons making submissions must not release them without the approval of the Committee.
