A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the *Vehicle and Traffic Act 1999*

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Vehicle and Traffic Amendment Act 2008*.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, the *Vehicle and Traffic Act 1999** is referred to as the Principal Act.

4. Section 67 amended (Evidentiary certificates)

Section 67 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (2B) the following subsection:

- (2C) A certificate signed by the Commission certifying that a speed-limit sign, within the meaning of the *Road Rules*, was displaying a specified speed limit at a specified time and place is admissible in legal proceedings as evidence of those matters so certified and, in the absence of evidence to the contrary, as proof of those matters.
