MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS REGISTRATION AMENDMENT BILL 2007

A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the *Medical Practitioners Registration Act* 1996

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Medical Practitioners Registration Amendment Act 2007*.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, the *Medical Practitioners* Registration Act 1996* is referred to as the Principal Act.
