INQUIRY INTO GOVERNMENT FUNDING OF AUSTRALIAN RULES COMMUNITY FOOTBALL IN TASMANIA

The Joint Parliamentary Standing Committee on Public Accounts has established an inquiry to examine the Government funding of Australian Rules community football in Tasmania and associated matters.

The Committee's Terms of Reference for the Inquiry are:

"To inquire into and report upon:

- The funding provided to AFL Tasmania by the Tasmanian Government and how that funding is expended to develop and support community football in Tasmania (including umpiring);
- The outcomes achieved in respect of the future and structure of community football in Tasmania and those who support and provide services to it as a result of that funding; and
- Any other matters incidental thereto".
