A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the Genetically Modified Organisms Control Act 2004

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Genetically* Modified Organisms Control Amendment Act 2014.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, the *Genetically Modified Organisms Control Act 2004** is referred to as the Principal Act.

4. Section 36 amended (Expiry)

Section 36 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "10 years" and substituting "15 years".

5. Repeal of Act

This Act is repealed on the three hundred and sixty fifth day from the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
