- 1 COUNCIL MEETS.**— The Council met at 11.00 o'clock in the forenoon.
- 2 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF TRADITIONAL PEOPLE.**— The President said: “We meet today on Tasmanian Aboriginal land. We acknowledge and pay respect to the Tasmanian Aboriginal people and elders, past and present. We recognise them as the traditional and original owners and the continuing custodians of this land.”
- 3 PRAYERS.**— The President read Prayers.
- 4 PAPER.**— The Acting Clerk of the Council laid upon the Table the Legislature-General Annual Report 2021-22.
- 5 SITTING SUSPENDED.**— *Resolved*, That the Sitting of the Council be suspended until the ringing of the Division bells. (Mrs *Hiscutt*)
The Sitting was suspended at 11.04 o'clock a.m. and resumed at 12.00 o'clock p.m.
- 6 BILL NO. 47.**— The Order of the Day was read for the Second reading of the Expansion of House of Assembly Bill 2022.
A Motion was made (Mrs *Hiscutt*), and the Question was proposed, That the Bill be now read the Second time.
A Debate arose thereupon.
Ordered, That the Debate be adjourned. (Ms *Forrest*)
- 7 BILL NO. 49.**— The Order of the Day was read for the Second reading of the Appropriation (Supplementary Appropriation for 2022-23) Bill 2022.
A Motion was made (Mrs *Hiscutt*), and the Question was proposed, That the Bill be now read the Second time.
A Debate arose thereupon.
- 8 SITTING SUSPENDED.**— It being 1.00 o'clock p.m. the Sitting of the Council was suspended.
The Council resumed the Sitting at 2.30 o'clock p.m.
- 9 QUESTION TIME.**— The President called for Questions without Notice. There were six Questions asked.
- 10 BILL NO. 49.**— The Council resumed the Debate on the Question, That the Appropriation (Supplementary Appropriation for 2022-23) Bill 2022 be now read the Second time.

And the Question being put,

It was resolved in the Affirmative.

And the Bill was, accordingly, read the Second time and committed to a Committee of the Whole Council.

And the President having left the Chair, the Council resolved itself into the said Committee.

Ms Forrest in the Chair.

Clauses 1 to 3 agreed to.

Clauses 4 and 5 postponed.

Clause 6 agreed to.

Schedule 1 agreed to.

Postponed Clauses 4 and 5 further considered and agreed to.

Title agreed to.

Bill to be reported without Request.

The Council being resumed, *Ms Forrest* reported that the Committee had gone through the Bill, and directed her to report the same to the Council without Request.

Ordered, That the Third reading of the Bill be made an Order of the Day for tomorrow. (*Mrs Hiscutt*)

11 BILL NO. 39.— The Order of the Day was read for the Second reading of the Stadiums Tasmania Amendment (Transfers) Bill 2022.

A Motion was made (*Mrs Hiscutt*), and the Question was proposed, That the Bill be now read the Second time.

A Debate arose thereupon.

12 SITTING SUSPENDED.— It being 4.00 o'clock p.m. the Sitting of the Council was suspended.

The Council resumed the Sitting at 4.30 o'clock p.m.

13 MOTION WITHOUT NOTICE.— *Ordered*, That *Mrs Hiscutt* have leave to move a Motion without Notice.

14 LEAVE OF ABSENCE.— *Ordered*, That the Honourable Member for Nelson (*Ms Webb*) be granted leave of absence from the service of the Council for the remainder of this day's sitting and for tomorrow's sitting. (*Mrs Hiscutt*)

15 BILL NO. 39.— The Council resumed Debate on the Question, That the Stadiums Tasmania Amendment (Transfers) Bill 2022 be now read the Second time.

And the Question being put,

It was resolved in the Affirmative.

And the Bill was, accordingly, read the Second time and committed to a Committee of the Whole Council.

And the President having left the Chair, the Council resolved itself into the said Committee.

Ms *Forrest* in the Chair.

Clauses 1 to 13 agreed to.

Title agreed to.

Bill to be reported without Amendment.

The Council being resumed, Ms *Forrest* reported that the Committee had gone through the Bill, and directed her to report the same to the Council without Amendment.

Ordered, That the Third reading of the Bill be made an Order of the Day for tomorrow. (Mrs *Hiscutt*)

16 BILL NO. 30.— The Order of the Day was read for the Second reading of the Retail Leases Bill 2022.

A Motion was made (Mrs *Hiscutt*), and the Question was proposed, That the Bill be now read the Second time.

A Debate arose thereupon.

Ordered, that the Debate be adjourned. (Ms *Forrest*)
