

## CLAUSE NOTES

### *Building (Consequential Amendments) Bill 2016*

- Clause 1: **Short title**
- Sets out the name of the proposed Act.
- Clause 2: **Commencement**
- Will commence on the same day as the *Building Act 2016*. Provision is made for certain clauses not to commence if related legislation has not yet commenced.
- Clause 3: **Consequential amendments of statutory rules do not prevent their subsequent amendment**
- Allows for further amendment of statutory rules following the commencement of this Act.
- Clause 4: **Administration of Act**
- The administration of this Act is assigned to the Minister for Building and Construction through the Department of Justice.
- Clause 5: **Consequential Amendments**
- The legislation specified in Schedule 1 is amended. References to the *Building Act 2000* are replaced by the *Building Act 2016*. References to building and plumbing regulations are updated to refer to *Building Regulations 2016* and *Plumbing Regulations 2016*.
- Clause 6: **Consequential Amendments**
- The legislation specified in Schedule 2 is amended. References to the *Building Act 2000* are replaced by the *Building Act 2016*. References to building and plumbing regulations are updated to refer to *Building Regulations 2016* and *Plumbing Regulations 2016*.
- Clause 7: **Consequential Amendments**
- The legislation specified in Schedule 3 is amended. References to the *Building Act 2000* are replaced by the *Building Act 2016*. References to building and plumbing regulations are updated to refer to *Building Regulations 2016* and *Plumbing Regulations 2016*.
